Subject: Policy for allocation of Bangladesh Railway (BDR) quota & other indents covered under quota for supply of rakes.

Ref: EDTT/F, Railway Board letter no. 2021/TT-VI/71/BDR/04/Quota dated 10.08.2022

Railway Board allots many quota to each zonal railway for loading of commodities (Wheat, Rice, Maize, DOC etc.) for Bangladesh via Darsana, Rohanpur, Benapole, Birol & Chilahati based on the pending indents.

Policy for quota distribution is as under-

1. The allotment of quota will be done by rotation within three divisions of NCR on commodity i.e. Wheat, Maize & DOC and destinations i.e. DSN, RIP, BEN & BLE etc. basis.
2. Divisions getting quota for a destination/commodity will allot the rake on the basis of ODR of indents keeping in view of all necessary formalities as per Railway Board policy.
3. If all the indents of a division are cancelled/forfeited, then the quota will be passed on to next division in queue and so on.
4. The indents pending on the last day of the month will be under consideration for allotment of rake i.e. quota for July, indents up to 30th June will be in line of consideration.
5. The fresh indents will be considered for allotment only when there is no valid indent of previous month is available.
6. If separate quota is received for Food grains along with Wheat, Rice, Maize etc. then in such situations indents pertaining to those commodity {within sub commodity of Food grains as defined in group 9 (General classification of goods) of IRCA - Goods traffic no 49, Part1 (vol.II) and part II} for which separate quota has been received, will not be considered for loading against quota for 'Food grains'. In other words loading for Food grains quota will be considered for only those commodities (sub commodities of Food grains) for which no separate quota has been issued.
7. Chief controller freight/HQ will maintain the record of quota allotment "Division wise, Destination wise and Commodity wise" and put up the relevant records to CFTM for allotment of quota to divisions once received from Railway Board.
8. Chief Controller/Freight/HQ will communicate the allotment of quota to divisions well in advance.
9. Sr. DOM/ DOM of divisions will do the allotment of rake accordingly.
The policy is implemented with immediate effect.
