The Employment notice no. SQ 2012-13 dated 23.06.2012 published in Employment News Dated 23-29 June 2012 for filling up 31 posts against sports quota pended vide notification published in employment news dated 4-10 August 2012 in terms of Railway Board's letter no. 2012/E (Sports)/4(1)/1/Policy Clarifications dated 26.06.2012 is cancelled and a fresh Employment notice calling applications from eligible sports persons is published as under:

- All the sports persons/applicants applied earlier against notification no. SQ 2012-13 dated 23-06-2012 published in employment news dated 23-29 June 2012 are required to submit a fresh application in reference to this notification.
- Applications submitted against earlier notification will not be taken into consideration anymore.
- Accordingly a fresh applications are invited from talented sports persons having sports norms as given in Para 6 below for recruitment on Group-'C' & erstwhile Group-'D' posts against Sports Quota 2012-13 on North Central Railway on the prescribed format, in the following games:

6. SPORTS' NORMS FOR RECRUITMENT:

6.3 **Badminton & Table Tennis:** Sportspersons may also be considered for recruitment on the basis of their current annual All India Rankings up to 12th position in Senior category in Single event, up to 4th position in Double event and up to 6th position in Youth/Junior category in Signal event in Grade Pay Rs. 19000 or **Rs. 2000 PB-I Rs. 5200-20200**.

6.4 **Golf:** Sportspersons having Indian Golf Union (I.G.U.) ranking up to 100, subject to single handicap i.e. less than 10 (in order of Merit/Amateur merit list) shall also be eligible for recruitment against the post having Grade Pay **Rs.1800** in Pay Band **Rs. 5200-20200**. Only the current annual All India Ranking shall be considered.

6.5 **Hockey (Men & Women):** In Hockey for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay **Rs. 1900** or **Rs. 2000** in Pay Band **Rs. 5200-20200** at least 2nd position in the International Tournaments of four or more nations, may also be considered. Participation in these tournaments may be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay **Rs.1800** in Pay Band **Rs. 5200-20200**.

- Note:** (a) All the recruitments shall be at the minimum of the scale of pay.

7. MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

- a) For the post having GP Rs. 1800 – Pass in Matric or ITI or its equivalent.
b) For the post having GP Rs. 1900 & 2000 – Pass in Matric or ITI or higher education.
c) For the post having GP Rs. 2400(Technical)– i) Pass in 1st year B.Sc (Physics) or
ii) Pass 10 + 2 stage in Higher Secondary in Science i.e. Maths or Physics.
d) For the post having GP Rs. 2800 – A university Degree or its equivalent.

8. AGE: 18 - 25 years as on 01.01.2013. No age relaxation is permissible to SC/ST/OBC.

9. PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS: The sports achievements of current & previous two financial years will be taken into account for eligibility. **Therefore, the sports achievements on or after 01.04.2010 will only be considered.**

10. HOW TO APPLY: Application as per the format enclosed at annexure 'A' shall be submitted on A-4 size good quality paper. **The application format should be in English or Hindi language only and should be filled in English or Hindi only. The applications submitted in other than English or Hindi language will be summarily rejected.** The application duly filled in all respect should be signed in running script in Hindi and English both at the appropriate place. The candidate has to affix one recent passport size front view photograph in normal attire without sunglasses/wigs on the application in the space provided for the purpose. Candidate is also advised to attach one identical extra passport size photograph along with the application.

Note: Name and father's name may preferably be written in English capital letters only.

11. EXAMINATION FEE:

The candidates have to send a crossed Indian Postal Order drawn in favour of Dy. CPO/R, North Central Railway/Allahabad payable at Allahabad as detailed below:

- a) For the post having GP Rs. 2400 – 2800 – Rs. 60.
b) For the post having GP Rs. 1800, 1900 & 2000 – Rs. 40.

NOTE:

- i. All women candidates, SC/ST/Muslims/Christians/Sikhs Buddhists/Zorastrians (Parsis) candidates are exempted from payment of examination fees.
ii. Economically backward class candidates whose family income is less than Rs. 50,000 per annum are exempted from examinations fees (They have to produce income certificate on letter head in prescribed format as shown in **Annexure 'E'**)

12. WHOM TO APPLY:

Application complete in all respect should be sent in a cover addressed to Assistant Personnel Officer/Recruitment, Railway Recruitment Cell, North Central Railway, Nawab Yusuf Road, Valmiki Chauraha, Allahabad (U.P) Pin Code – 211001 so as to reach on or before last date i.e. 31.12.2012. Application may also be dropped in the box kept in the Railway Recruitment Cell Office, Nawab Yusuf Road, Valmiki Chauraha, Allahabad on any working day (Monday to Friday) between 09.30 hrs to 18.00 hrs on or before last date. Candidates belonging to Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep Islands closing date would be 15.01.2013, time upto 18.00 hrs. Such candidates should enclose a domicile certificate of Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep Islands from and appropriate authority of the Andaman, Nicobar Administration or a certificate from a school or college last attended in Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep certifying that the candidate has passed his/her examination from the school/college situated in Andaman, Nicobar & Lakshadweep.

13. RECRUITMENT PROCESS: The recruitment will be based on trials followed by Dope Test, assessment of sports achievements and general intelligence/personality etc. The candidates **who are found fit** in trials will only be considered for next stage of recruitment process. An application/candidature of a candidate can be rejected at any stage, if found false and Railway will not communicate the reasons whatsoever.

14. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- (a) Before applying to the post, the candidate should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility norms as given in Para 6 above.
- (b) The name and initial of the candidate and father's name appearing in school/college certificates and in sports certificates should be one and the same. There should be no difference.
- (c) The specific position (Half/Forward/Fullback/62 Kg. /77 Kg. /85 Kg etc.) played in the particular game/event if applicable should be mentioned in the application without fail.
- (d) The candidates already employed in Central/States/PSUs including Railways should submit their applications through proper channel along with "no objection certificate" from their employer.
- (e) Canvassing in any form shall disqualify the candidate.
- (f) The candidates should be in readiness to appear for the trials at short notice after the last date for receipt of applications is over.

14.1. Proficiency in Typing Skill: The Sports persons recruited as Clerk or Sr. Clerk against sports quota should pass the requisite type writing test within the prescribed period from the date of their appointment.

14.2. Medical Examination: The sports persons recruited against sports quota shall fulfill the minimum medical norms for the post, for which he/she is being appointed.

14.3 Probation period: All the sports persons recruited against sports quota will undergo probation period of two years.

14.4 Service Bond: The "Service Bond" period for the persons recruited against sports quota shall be of five years.

16. INVALID APPLICATIONS: Application of the candidates having any of the following discrepancies or irregularities will be summarily rejected:
