Sub: Revised Scale/authorisation of Rifle(SLR)  
7.62 mm and its training ammunition, for  
RPF and RPSF.

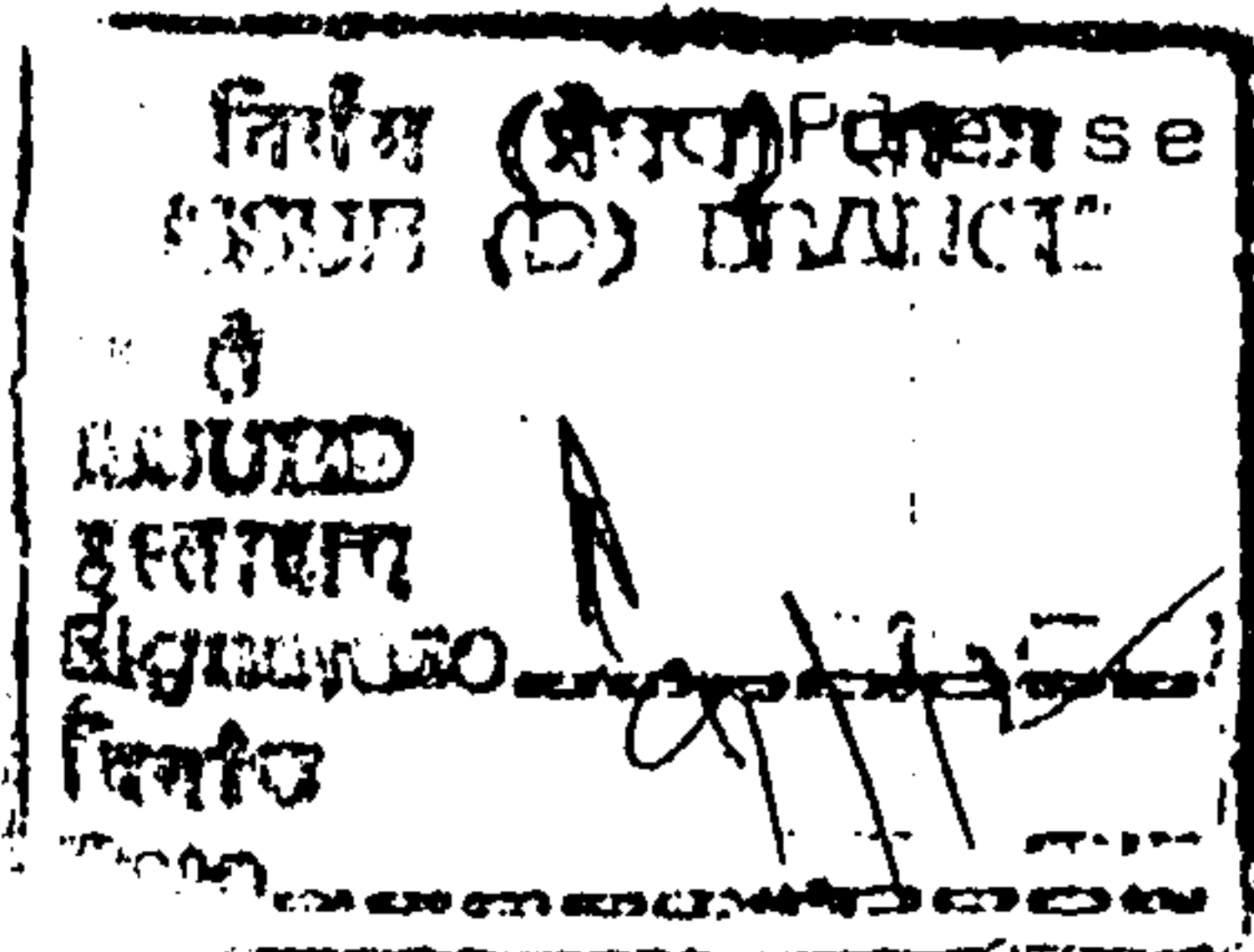
In terms of Standing Order No.33 of 1997 issued  
vide Board's letter of even number dated 4.8.97, the  
scale/authorisation of Rifle(SLR) 7.62mm and its ammunition  
has been laid down for RPSF only. No authorisation of  
this weapon and its ammunition has, however, been made  
therein for RPF.


Training in Rifle(SLR) 7.62mm, for RPF Constable  
Recruits and Sub-Inspector/Cadets has since been introduced  
in the Training Manual, vide Standing Order No.51 of  
1998 issued vide Board's letter No.98/Sec(Spl)/6/6 dated  
26.3.98.

It has, therefore, been decided to authorise  
Rifles(SLR) 7.62mm to RPF also, at par with RPSF. Accordingly  
in continuation to the Standing Order No. 33 of 1997, the  
scale/authorisation of training ammunition for Rifle(SLR)  
7.62mm is also fixed as under:

Rifle(SLR) 7.62mm  
(RPF & RPSF)

- 50 rounds per
