Standing Order No: 99

Sub:- Modality for test of knowledge of English in the departmental examination u/r 70 of RPF Rules 1987.

In order to test the knowledge of English separately, wherever deemed fit, in the departmental examination for promotion to the rank of SI & IPF in RPF/RPSF, guidelines are laid down as under:

1.) During the selection u/r 70 of RPF Rules 1987 for promotion to the rank of Sub Inspector and Inspector, if Chief Security Commissioner of the concerned zone deems fit that the knowledge of English is considered essential for the discharge of day to day functions of the relevant category of employees, the same may be separately tested.


2.) Only those candidates will be tested for English who opt to write the answers in the prescribed written test in Hindi or Regional language. The test should be conducted as under: -

1.) The English paper shall be meant to test the knowledge of English expected to be used while working. No direct questions shall be asked on English Grammar

2.) (a) The English paper shall be of 50 marks (maximum)

(b) It shall not form part of the total marks given in the para 14(a) of Standing Order 87.

(c) The duration of the test shall be 2 hours.



(d) Subjective type questions to the extent of 50% of marks prescribed for written test should be set and may include: -

- (i) Essay in English (The candidate shall be asked to write the essay, related to situations associated with RPF working)
- (ii) Précis writing (The candidate shall be asked to write the précis in 1/3rd of the total no. of words of the given passage. The passage should be relevant to the working of RPF)
- (iii) Report writing by using the words or group of words given. (The choice of the words given should be related to RPF working) and the candidate shall be asked to write the report, related to situations associated with RPF working.

(e) Objective type questions should be set for the remaining 50% of marks and may include: -

- (i) "True/False" type of Questions from the passage given. (related to the situations associated with RPF working)
- (i) Match the following (related to the situations associated with RPF working)
- (ii) Fill in the blanks (related to the situations associated with RPF working)

3.) The candidates of Gen category obtaining 50% and of SC/ST category obtaining 40% of the total marks (i.e. 50 marks) shall be considered as having passed the test of English language.

4.) ***Candidates who fail to qualify the above test shall not be promoted***


Example for 2(d)(iii): -

CT/Rohit chased and caught him by his neck. Rohit also seized the bag, which was in the hands of the culprit. On being asked, the culprit disclosed that his name was Manohar....."



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
