

Function North Central Railway

The North Central Railway is headquartered at Allahabad and comprises of three divisions: Allahabad Division, Jhansi Division and Agra Division. The medical facilities are channeled through different units, at different levels, a health unit, being the lowest, under the charge of ADMO/DMO/SR.DMO/ACMS. There are one Central Hospital at ALD under the charge of Medical Director, two Divisional, at Agra & Jhansi under the charge of CMSs, two Sub-divisional Hospitals, at Kanpur & Tundla. Kanpur under the charge of CMS & Tundla under the charge of ACMS.

The foundation stone of this hospital was laid in March 1924 by Sir Harry. G. Waters, the then CMO of East Indian Railway. Later on, this became Divisional Hospital for ALD Division under Northern Railway in 1952. The first DMO of the hospital was Dr.E.F. Labord. The post of DMO was upgraded to MS in 1976, to ACMO in 1981 and to CMS in the year 1986. This hospital was converted to Central Hospital, N.C. Railway w.e.f. October 2005. The modified building plan was approved by GM/NCR IN 2014.

New OPD and Administrative block was inaugurated in April 2009. It caters to the needs of the employees and their families and RELHS holders and families.
