

Action Plan of identified Agra cantt Station of North Central Railway in reference of orders of Hon'ble NGT in O.A.No.141/2014 in the matter of Saloni Singh & Ors. Vs. Union of India & Ors.

1	Provision of two dustbins for 100% collection of Municipal solid waste from all the stations.	Two bin dustbins have already been provided and being monitored regularly
2	Management of Cleanliness staff	Bio-metric attendance of cleanliness staff is being ensured and all statutory provisions of labour law like minimum wages, bonus, ESI, periodic rest etc. are being followed.
3	CCTV cameras installed for monitoring of littering.	CCTV cameras are already in place for monitoring of littering.
4	Public awraeness campaign	Announcement and video display are being done at stations regularly using public addressing system.
5	Achievement of Environment standard. 'ISO-14001'.	Efforts for certification already in place. Will be achived by 30/06/2019.
6	Water and Energy Audit to undertaken.	Water Audit of AGC station was taken out in Nov-2015 and Energy Audit of AGC station was taken out on 17.01.2017
7	Railway station should have their own website to receive grievances and suggestions, particularly with regard to cleanliness and hygiene issues.	Public grievances and suggestion received through complaint register and 138 service.
8	Nos. of ETP/STP/WRPs installed	WRP has been comissioned at Coaching depot AGC, just adjascent to the station
9	Number of toilets provided in areas surrounding the track to prevent open defecation including provided by civil authorities. Also, coordination with urban local bodies for the same.	Sufficient toilets are avialable on platform and circulating area.
10	Removal of encroachment ets. Circulating and nearby areas.	Implementation and monitoring mechanism with the provision of fixing accountability of notified individual at railway station level already exists on NCR. For this a Joiny procedure order has been issued vide letter No. ADRM/Infra/Agra/50 dt.20.12.17. Total 5 encroachments have removed in circulating and nearby areas.
11	Collection, Segregation and disposal of plastic Waste.	At present in the above stations is having mechanized cleaning contract in which the work of rag-picking has been included. The collected garbage is dumped at the main dumpsters provided by Muncipal Corporation.
12	Solid waste generation and its disposal as per' Solid waste and Plastic Management Rule' 2016 including co-ordination with concerned local bodies for solid and plastic waste mamagement and banning use of Plastic on Railway Stations. Arrangement of disposal if inorganic (dry) waste through material recovery facility. Definite arrangement for utilisatuon of organic (wet) waste	Solid waste disposal is being ensured in co-ordination with concerned local bodies.

13	Afforestation and plantation with the help of the forest departments of state government	Efforts are being done for signing of agreement with forest department as per MOU, but agreement could not be reached. Regular chasing being done to reach an agreement. Special Vriksharopan driver are organised regularly all over the division.
14	System to identify and penalise for littering. System to tackle the polluter of railway land. System to make stations litter free and dust free	Fines are being collected from polluters for throwing or littering any waste in Railway premises, in accordance with the Indian Railways (Penalties for activities affecting cleanliness at Railway Premises Rule 2012) Staff engaged in mechanized cleaning of stations collects the litter at stations under section 145 and Segregate in twin dustbins which is further disposed off at the dumpsters provided by municipal corporation.
15	Special task force for removal of encroachments	Special task force involving RPF, Engg, Traffic and Commercial inspectors has been formed for removal of encroachment.
