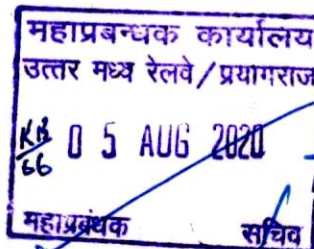

Sub: General Departmental Competitive Examination.

In terms of extant instructions 25% to 50% of DR quota vacancies in categories where there is an element of at least 25% DR quota can be filled up by GDCE. However, it is observed that vacancies filled up through GDCE have been inadequate during the last two years.

As the Railway Administration would be aware, this examination allows qualified and meritorious staff in the lower grades an opportunity to fast track their career.

Keeping in view the large number of vacancies still prevailing on the Railways, Railways may make additional efforts to fill up vacancies through GDCE within the prescribed limits. Zonal Railways are also requested to provide suggestions on ways this scheme can be made more effective. These may be provided latest by 10.08.2020.
