Should you come across any instance of malpractice or corruption in any sphere of Railway working, please take the trouble of informing us. It will be helpful if you could note all the relevant details like description of the train, place, time and date and designation of the railway personnel concerned, name and address of the witness, etc. The information would be treated as confidential but the railway may have to seek your cooperation to tender evidence during the course of the investigation/inquiries to help bring the culprits to book. 3. Functions of Organisation

- Undertake prompt investigation of authenticated complaints.
- Carry out preventive checks with follow up investigations on serious cases of irregularities based on source information.
- Ensure speedy processing of vigilance cases at all stages.
- Undertake regular review of vigilance cases.
- Ensure the speedy processing of D&AR inquiries.
- Preventive vigilance.
- Disseminate awareness about vigilance through awareness activities.
- Maintain close liaison with CVC and CBI.

4. Organisation Structure

North Central Railway Vigilance Organization is headed by SDGM & CVO. He is assisted by one Chief Vigilance Officers viz. CVO(E) and four Dy Chief Vigilance Officers viz. Dy CVO(S), Dy CVO(T), Dy CVO(M) and Dy CVO (El).
