# **MAHAKUMBH**

The term 'Kumbh' comes from the root 'Kumbhak' (the sacred pitcher of elixir of immortality). There is a mention of 'Kumbh' and the bathing ritual associated with it in the Rig Veda. It speaks of the benefit of bathing at sangam during this period, elimination of negative influences and rejuvenation of mind and soul. Prayers for the 'Kumbh' are also expressed in Atharva Veda and Yajur Veda.

It recounts how Gods and demons fought over the sacred pitcher (Kumbh) of Amrit (nectar of immortality) called the Ratna of Samudra Manthan. It is widely believed that Lord Vishnu (disguised as the enchantress 'Mohani') whisked the Kumbh out of the grasp of the covetous demons who had tried to claim it. As he took it heavenwards, a few drops of the precious nectar fell on the four sacred site we know as Haridwar, Ujjain, Nashik and Prayag.

The Kumbh Mela is the largest public gathering and collective act of faith, anywhere in the world. The Mela draws tens of millions of pilgrims over the course of approximately 45 days to bathe at the sacred confluence of the Ganga, the Yamuna, and the mystical Saraswati. Primarily, this congregation includes Ascetics, Saints, Sadhus, Sadhvis, Kalpvasis, and Pilgrims from all walks of life.

## **PRAYAGRAJ CITY**

In 600 BC, there was a kingdom covering the part of present district of Prayagraj. It was called 'Vatsa' with capital as 'Kaushambi', the remains of which still lies south-west of Prayagarj. Gautam Buddha also honoured this city with his three visits. After this, the region came under the Mauryan rule, Kaushambi was made the headquarter of one of the provincials of 'Ashoka'. Under his instructions two monolithioc pillers were erected at Kaushambi one of which later shifted to Prayagraj. Prayagraj has been the hub of politics and education. University of Allahabad was once known as Oxford of East. The city has given large number of political leaders, including three Prime Ministers to the country. It has been the centre of literature, art as well as the movement for freedom of India from British Empire.

During Kumbh Mela some restrictions shall be imposed at Railway stations for passengers safety and their smooth evacuation. Restriction period shall be from D-1 to D+2 where 'D' is main bathing day.

#### **DURING RESTRICTION PERIOD:-**

#### PRAYAGRAJ JUNCTION:-

- Entry shall be given from City side (PF-1 side) only.
- Exit shall be allowed towards Civil Lines side only.
- ➤ Direction wise movement through *Yatri Ashray* for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.
- > Separate entry of reserved passengers shall be given through Gate no. 5 from City side.
- Reserved passengers will be allowed on platforms only 30 minutes before arrival of their trains.

# **NAINI JUNCTION:-**

- Entry shall be given from Station road only.
- $\triangleright$  Exit shall be given towards Malgodam side (2<sup>nd</sup> entry) only.
- ➤ Direction wise movement through *Yatri Ashray* for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

# PRAYAGRAJ CHHEOKI STATION:-

- Entry shall be given from COD road only connecting Prayagraj-Mirzapur highway.
- Exit shall be given towards GEC Naini road (1st entry) only.
- ➤ Direction wise *Yatri Ashray* for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

#### **SUBEDARGANJ STATION:-**

- > Entry shall be given from Jhalwa side only.
- Exit shall be given towards GT road side only.
- > Yatri Ashray for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

## **PRAYAG JUNCTION:-**

- > Entry shall be given from Chaitham line (PF-1) only.
- Exit shall be given towards Rampriya road (PF-4) only.
- ➤ Direction wise movement through *Yatri Ashray* for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

#### PHAPHAMAU STATION:-

- $\triangleright$  Entry shall be given from 2<sup>nd</sup> Entry side (PF-4) only.
- Exit shall be given towards Phaphamau Bazar (PF-1) only.
- > Direction wise movement through *Yatri Ashray* for unreserved passengers.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

# **PRAYAGRAJ RAMBAG STATION:-**

- > Entry shall be given from Main Entry towards Hanuman Mandir Chauraha only.
- > Exit shall be given towards Lowther road only.
- ➤ Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

# JHUSI STATION:-

- > Entry and exit shall be given from both side of the station.
- > Ticketing arrangements in enclosures in the form of counters, ATVMs and Mobile ticketing.

<u>Note:</u> - *Prayagraj Sangam Station* will remain closed on main bathing days(D-1 to D+2).

#### **IMPORTANT POINTS TO NOTE**

- 1. Beware of pick-pockets.
